3. Open to all students in grades 9-12 currently attending public, private, military or home school
4. Recipient must be planning to attend a Board approved two or four year public/private university or vocational, technical, or trade school located in the United States

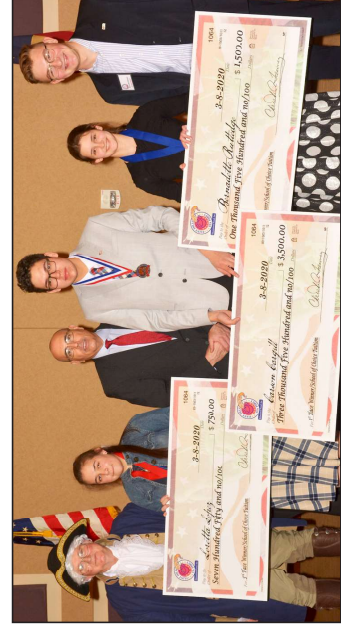

Selection and Process

1. Each student submits a completed application
2. Applications are reviewed by a panel of judges
3. Participants are selected
4. Participants are then notified
5. Participants review study materials
6. Participants make plans to attend the event

Frequently Asked Questions

How much is awarded each year? *The amount is determined by the funding available.*

How much is the annual scholarship worth? *All finalists will be recognized for their participation. Previous scholarship awards have totaled annually \$5,750.00.*

Am I eligible to participate and win a scholarship each year? *Yes, we encourage your participation. Winnings will accrue each year in a separate account.*

When are scholarship funds available? *At the time of verified enrollment.*

What’s the event format? *Winners are determined through questions based on the Declaration of Independence, the U.S. Constitution, Founding Documents, and Federalist Papers (visit our website for a more complete list of study resources) utilizing multiple choice and an oral presentation.*
